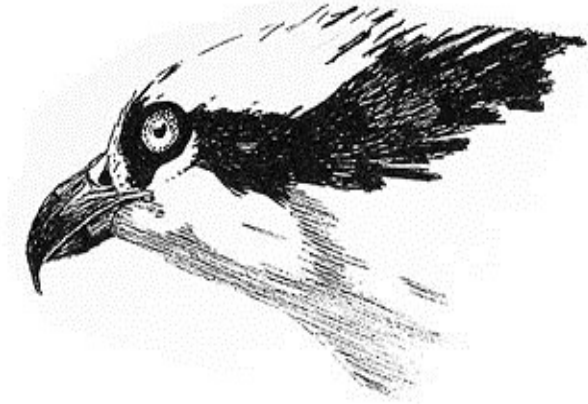


Checklist of the Birds of Kiawah Island, South Carolina

Su: Summer - June to August

F: Fall - September to November

W: Winter - December to February

Seasonal Abundance

- c:** Common—certain to be seen in suitable habitat
u: Uncommon—present but not certain to be seen
o: Occasional—seen only a few times during a season
r: Rare—seen at intervals of 2 to 5 years
x: Accidental—out of normal range
*****: Nests on Kiawah Island, or did so in recent years
^: Federally listed as Endangered
