BIRD WALK AT MINGO POINT

1 hour | Ages 8+

Mingo Point is a unique spot situated between the gorgeous salt marsh along the Kiawah River and the maritime forest of Kiawah Island. Join a Naturalist on this birding tour to get a taste of the great birds Kiawah Island has to offer all in one place, from flocks of singing red-winged blackbirds to wood storks and egrets wading in the pluff mud. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

GATOR WALK

1 hour | Ages 4+

The American Alligator is a guest favorite and one of our most intriguing wildlife species. Join a naturalist as we visit some gator habitats and learn how these prehistoric creatures survive on Kiawah.

BIRDING FOR BEGINNERS

1.5 hours | Ages 10+

This walking tour is just what you need to learn the birding basics. A Naturalist will lead you on a walk through various types of habitats in the park to learn where specific birds are found and what to look for when identifying each species. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

BIRD WALK AT THE OCEAN COURSE

2 hours | Ages 14+

The Ocean Course is home to some of the richest bird habitats on Kiawah Island. Freshwater ponds, salt marshes, and the beach come together to create an incredibly diverse habitat for shorebirds, wading birds, and songbirds, among many others. Join a Naturalist on this unique birdwatching tour to learn about the bird species that make Kiawah Island such a special place. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

REPTILE ROUND UP

1 hour | Ages 6+

Have you ever wondered what makes a reptile so unique? Are you interested in meeting native turtles, snakes, and even alligators? This classroom demonstration is the perfect way to familiarize yourself with some of Kiawah's lovely reptiles. Focusing on fun, useful facts, and handson experiences, your Naturalist will be there to answer any and all questions you and your family may have!





ADULT SUNSET PADDLE

WILDLIFE IN THE WETLANDS

2 hous | Ages 8+

A Naturalist favorite: this tour will take you on a leisurely bike ride to discover the fascinating wildlife that inhabits Kiawah Island's diverse ecosystems. You'll gain a better understanding of the beaches, dunes, maritime forest, ponds, and salt marshes that stretch across the island, while learning each ecosystem's unique characteristics. 1.5 hours | All Ages Welcome

SUNSET CRUISE

1.5 hours | All Ages Welcome

There's no better way to end your day than a leisurely cruise along the calm waters of the salt marsh. Maximize the amount of time spent with your family and friends as you relax and enjoy the beauty of a Kiawah sunset.

NEAR COASTAL & REEF FISHING

4 hours | Ages 9+

Near Coastal Fishing takes place 1-3 miles offshore, where we will bottom fish around off shore wrecks and artificial reefs. Target species include redfish, wreckfish, black sea bass, triggerfish, spadefish, and many different seasonal species. Catch-and-release only. Maximum of 6 guests.

INSHORE FISHING

4 hours | Ages 5+

Join our tournament-winning Captains as we travel Kiawah Island's creeks and marshes to experience the best fishing the Lowcountry has to offer. Target species include redfish, black drum, sheepshead, trout, and various seasonal species. Catch-and-release only. Maximum of 6 quests.

KIAWAH RIVER CREEK FISHING

A shorter version of our Inshore Fishing Charter. We'll stay in the smaller channels and creeks for a chance to catch some of Kiawah Island's common saltwater fishes. Catch-and-release only. Maximum of 6 guests.

SHELLING EXPEDITION

2 hours | All Ages Welcome

South Carolina's rich ecosystem provides a variety of unique marine mollusks that leave behind a legacy of beautiful shells. Accessible only by water, we'll journey to a remote barrier island known for its shells. We encourage photos and apply collecting limits to help conserve the beach and its inhabitants for future generations.



ALLIGATOR ADVENTURE

2 hous | Ages 6+

From tiny hatchlings to imposing adults, there are alligators in almost every pond on Kiawah Island. Travel with us as we search our Naturalists' favorite gator hangouts for these impressive predators. This is a fantastic way to observe and learn about these amazing and often misunderstood animals in their natural habitat. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

BACK ISLAND BIRDING

3 hous | Ages 14+

From tiny hummingbirds and vibrant warblers to majestic birds of prey, the Lowcountry of South Carolina is famous for its diversity of birds during all seasons. We'll use our van to reach several remote island habitats to seek out dozens of bird species and learn about the natural history of our avian wildlife. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

With cooler November temperatures, we don't bid farewell to our feathery friends - we welcome more! As the season transitions, we greet the visually-stunning Hooded Merganser among other guests like ducks, grebes and loons! Alongside them, steadfast winter dwellers like sparrows, goldfinches, and Hermit Thrushes make our island their home too. As December brings in colder waves, Brown Pelicans, particularly the juveniles, find their way to our ponds for a hearty feast. Bald Eagles invest time in building and

repairing their nests and Cedar Waxwings are a sight to behold, often seen congregating in groups of hundreds high up in the trees!

Prepare your binoculars and cameras - Kiawah Island winter birding is a spectacle not to be missed! Join our Naturalists for an unforgettable exploration of Kiawah Island and experience the marvels of island birdlife and more with our diverse range of winter Nature Tours. Choose from options such as Back Island Birding, Mingo Point Birding, Wildlife in the Wetlands Bike Tour, or explore the salt marsh on a kayak or motorboat cruise.
